CHITTAGONG, Apr. 23.—The closure of Chittagong University has been extended for 10 days more. The university will now reopen on May 4. The decision was taken at a meeting of the University Syndicate held today.

Chittagong University was closed on December 22 last year following clashes between two rival groups of students. The university was scheduled to reopen today after an unscheduled closure of 121 days. The halls of the university opened earlier are also closed for 10 days more and the students were asked to vacate the halls.

BSS adds: Chittagong University Central Students Union Vice-President Muhammad Nazimuddin and General Secretary Azimuddin in a statement tonight resented the decision of closure of the university

again today saying it an undemocratic and an interference in the autonomy of the university.

They said that the closure of the university again after long four months had thrown hundreds of students to uncertainty. They called for reopening of the university immediately.
