CU V-C allowed to leave campus

Chittagong Office

CHITTAGONG, May 31:—The gherao of the Vice-Chancellor of Chittagong University was withdrawn and he was allowed to leave his office chamber by the agitating students at around 11 p.m.

The Vice-Chancellor Prof Alamgir Mohammad Shirajuddin stayed besieged for long eight hours. The Vice-Chancellor came to the office to hold a meeting of the Syndicate. The Islami Chhatra Shibir through a Press release claimed that it put up a road around the office of Vice-Chancellor in support of demanded withdrawal of show cause on its 63 activists and expulsion order on five other activists. The Shibir claimed that its supporters gheraoed the Vice-Chancellor when he outright rejected to consider their demands.

Meanwhile, the Chittagong University Central Students Union (CUCSU) leaders including its Vice-President Mr. Nazimuddin in a joint statement expressed resentment for illegal gharao and confinement of the Vice Chancellor in presence of law enforcing agency. The Chittagong University Teachers Association (CUTA) in a resolution through an emergency meeting demanded the resignation of Vice-Chancellor by Saturday noon. The CUTA threatened to refrain from their duties next Sunday unless the Vice Chancellor resigns.
