CHITTAGONG, July 20:—The office of Chittagong University Vice-Chancellor remained under lock and key today in the face of demonstration of the supporters of the Samilito Chhatra Oikyo Parishad, a offshoot of the Islami Chhatra Shibir.

The Parishad supporters also kept the Vice-Chancellor office besieged for several hours. They also hoisted a black flag demanding the resignation of Vice-Chancellor Prof. Alamgir Mohammad Shirajuddin and implementation of the report of one man judicial commission.

However, the Vice-Chancellor did not come to attend his office today.

Except the Vice-Chancellor's office, the other administrative offices remaining out of the purview of action programme of the Parishad functioned as usual today. But there was no classes held at the university today. The number of students and teachers present on the campus was appeared very thin.

Nevertheless, the admission of students in honours class of Chittagong University carried out undisturbed despite this prolonged student unrest.
