Strike observed in Ctg Varsity

CHITTAGONG, Dec. 12:—A complete strike was observed in Chittagong University today at the call of Islami Chhatra Shibir.

The Shibir gave this strike call as part of three days of what in called anti-terrorism programmes.

The programmes also include rallies, demonstrations and processions.

The University could not hold any classes today due to the strike. The administrative work at the University also remained suspended.

A rally was held on the campus with Shibir's University Unit President Hamidur Rahman Azad in the chair.

The speakers at the rally reiterated

their demand for the resignation of incumbent Vice Chancellor.

The Sangrami Chhatra Oikya an extended body of the Islami Chhatra Shibir has also given a call for strike in Chittagong University next Sunday.

Meanwhile, the Chittagong University Terrorism Resistance Civic Committee suggested to close down the university dormitories temporarily to facilitate the ousting of terrorists from the campus.

The suggestion was put forward by the committee through a public meeting at Laldighi maidan on Wednesday afternoon. The meeting presided over by its convener Professor Mohammad Khaled was addressed among others by AL leader Mr. A.B.M. Mohiuddin, Akhtarun Nabi, Advocate Abul Kalam Azad, Advocate Ibrahim Hossain Babul and University teachers Dr. Hamida Banu Dr Iftekar Uddin Chowdhury and Prof. Anowarul Azim.
