

## All set for reopening of CU tomorrow

CHITTAGONG, Apr. 16.—All out preparations have been made to reopen the University of Chittagong tomorrow by the concerned authorities amid widespread speculations of last moment troubles.

However, Chittagong University, which will resume its classes after lapse of one and a half years, hopes that everything will pass off peacefully on the opening day.

The University is in the grip of crisis since the slaying of a student leader Farukuzzaman in a clash between two rival groups of students in December last year.

There are now seven platoons of police and ansars deputed to maintain law and order on the campus. Except the University students with genuine identity card none would be allowed to enter the campus. The resident students will be allowed to occupy their seats only after being proved of their genuineness. All political processions, meetings and gatherings are being banned. Three shuttle trains will ply two ways between Chittagong City and the University everyday from Saturday. Besides, 18 buses will travel between the city and campus daily for the transportation of 12,000 students.

Meanwhile, the Islami Chhatra Shibir presented a memorandum to the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Rafiqul Islam Chowdhury on Wednesday demanding the safety of students on arrival at the University.
