5 including CU teacher suspended for question leakage

CHITTAGONG, Oct. 17.—The Chittagong University Syndicate on Sunday suspended five university staff including a senior teacher on charge of their involvement in the leakage of questions of BBA admission test examinations.

The Syndicate in a meeting took this decision on the basis of an enquiry report submitted by a two-member committee.

The enquiry committee comprised Professor Abdul Nur and Dr Kazi Abdul Baset. The committee members inquired thrice into the allegation taking long eight months.

The five penalised persons are Professor Dr Jahirul Huq, chairman of Finance Department, peons Solaiman and Awal of Accounting Department, peon Belal of Faculty of Commerce and Baten, an employee of University cafeteria.

Besides, Dr Nuruddin Mahmud, a teacher of Marine Biology Department of the University was also held responsible for supply of copies to a student during the examination.

However, this is for the first time a teacher of Chittagong University has been put under suspension for an alleged involvement in the leakage of questions.

The members present at the Syndicate meeting included Engineer LK Siddique MP, Dr. Fasiul Alam, Dr Munir Ahmed Chowdhury, Social Science Faculty Dean Prof Abdul Hakim, Professor Fazle Hossain, Professor Nuruddin Chowdhury, Assistant Professor Abdul Karim, Lecturer Mizanur Rahman and SM Fazlul Huq. The Vice-Chancellor Professor Rafiqul Islam Chowdhury presided over the Syndicate meeting.
