Ctg JCD vows to resist Jamaat-Shibir

CHITTAGONG, Nov 23:—The JCD in Chittagong observed the (killers resistance day) today to protest the brutal murder of two JCD leaders at Chittagong Polytechnic Institute three days ago.

In this connection the JCD held a big rally at Laldighi Maidan today. The Fisheries and Livestock Minister Abdullah Al Noman attended the meeting as the chief guest.

Among the speakers were BNP's Central Finance Secretary Golam Akbar Khondokar Shirajul Islam MP, BNP's district leader M.A. Sabur and JCD leaders Iftexhar Hosain Mahsin, Mahubor Rahman Shamin, Jashimuddin Shikdar, Manzur Rahman Chowdhury, Shafiqur Rahman, Munirul Haq, Manir Azad Chowdhury and Saiful Alam. The city JCD unit President Nazimur Rahman presided over the meeting.

The speakers pledged to fight to the last to free the nation what they said from the clutches of anti-liberation forces and the killers of 1971 war of liberation. They said "without elimination of the seeds of this venomous Jamaat-Shibir force, there can not be any peace and tranquility in the country".

They vowed to wage an all out movement to resist all "evil designs" of the Jamaat-Shibir forces.

The JCD took out a number of mourning processions and held protest rallies in the past two days to protest the twin murder at Chittagong Polytechnical Institute.

The Awami League City Unit president M.A. Mannan and General Secretary and City Mayor A.B.M. Mohiuddin in a joint statement to the press condoled the death of two JCD leaders at the hands of the Shibir activists. They also criticised the Government for its failure to protect widespread destruction to vehicles and property by the unruly people.
