161 students demand CU reopening

CHITTAGONG, Jan. 20:— One hundreds sixtyone students of Honours and Masters candidates of the Chittagong University today demanded of the university authorities to reopen the university immediately and announce fresh date of the examinations of different academic years, reports BSS.

In a joint statement they said due to prolonged closure of the university, the future of the hundreds of students had become uncertain. Moreover the academic years of the Chittagong University were lagging behind in comparison to other universities of the country.

They urged all student organisations to come forward for taking united efforts so that the authorities reopen the university soon at the earliest.
