Ctg varsity forms probe committee

CHITTAGONG, Sept. 20.—The Chittagong University has constituted a committee comprising Proctor, all Deans of faculties, a Syndicate member and President and General Secretary of Shikkhok Samity (teachers association) to probe into the incidents that disrupted the academic life in the university over past three days.

The committee was set up at a meeting of senior teachers held at the Vice Chancellor's residence with Vice Chancellor Professor Rafiqul Islam Chowdhury in the chair. The pro-Vice-Chancellor Professor Abu Yusuf Alam was also present in the meeting.

The committee was asked to take into account the 6-point demand that were put up both by pro-AL Chhatra League and Islami Chhatra Shibir as precondition to resolve the present student unrest on the campus. The committee evaluating the whole gamut of situation in the university will suggest measures for solution of the problems as soon as possible.

Meanwhile, the university authority has sacked a fourth class employee Mohammad Shafi for his alleged involvement in the assault of a Chhatra League leader Abul Kashem last Tuesday.
