Administrative work in CU disrupted

CHITTAGONG, Mar. 9.—Administrative works at Chittagong University were disrupted today in the face of demonstration by a section of students.

The students, organised under the banner of "Subsidiary Examination Bottleneck Prevention Council", also kept the administrative building of the university under lock and key throughout the day to thwart the attendance of the officials and general employees. The Vice-Chancellor Prof. Abdul Mannan also could not attend his office.

The council, backed by Islami Chhatra Shibir, also called a strike in the university of Chittagong tomorrow (Monday) to press demand for removal of all bottlenecks in the subsidiary examinations.

The Council supporters held rallies and took out processions on the campus in support of their demand.

Three students also sustained injuries in a clash that ensued between the supporters of the Islamic Chhatra and Pro-Awami League Chhatra League (S-P). One of the injured student was identified as Rezaul Karim, an activist of the Islami Chhatra Shibir. He was beaten by the rival students when he was mixing in connection with the reception of freshers in the Department of Statistics.

Among Shibir activists, Alamgir Hossain was assaulted and injured by some rival students at Sholoshahar Rail Station on Sunday evening. The Shibir activist fell prey to the rage of opponents when he went to the station to avail the train for returning to the campus.
