Tense situation at CU

Chittagong Office.

CHITTAGONG, June 23:—A simmering situation now prevails in the University of Chittagong over the issue of naming of a girl students dormitory.

The newly built girl students dormitory named after the name of valiant freedom fighter Birkannya Pritilata Sen of British period at a Syndicate meeting held last Thursday.

While the supporters of the Islami Chhatra Shibir have launched a strong movement on the campus to get the name changed. The supporters of other student bodies—Chhatra League and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) lent their support to the naming of Birkannya Pritilata Hall.

Meanwhile, the Islami Chhatra Shibir has announced a package of five-day movement programme in the university with effect from Sunday to press for the cancellation of the name of Birkannya Pritilata Hall.

Under the movement programme, the Shibir undertook signature campaigns on June 22 and 23, will launch the drive for mass-contact with university teachers and employees on June 24 and 25, demonstrations at all educational institutions in Chittagong on June 25 and gherao of Chittagong University Vice chancellor's office on June 26.
