Shibir calls strike in CU today

CHITTAGONG, Apr. 27.—The Islami Chhatr Shibir has called strike in Chittagong University tomorrow (Tuesday).

The Jamaat-backed Shibir gave this strike call to protest what it called unprovoked attack and inflicting injuries on its supporters by the activists of pro-AL-Chahtra League.

As many as 30 students including Shibir's university unit general secretary sustained injuries in the clash that ensued between the supporters of two rival student bodies.

More than 200 Shibir activists gathered at F Rahman Hall (dormitory) on Monday afternoon to stage demonstration. They held a protest meeting and took out procession on the campus calling to make the strike tomorrow a success.

However, a tense situation now prevails in Chittagong University. The police are patrolling to maintain law and order there.
