ACSU observes strike in CU

CHITTAGONG, Aug 10:—

The first day of indefinite strike was observed in Chittagong University today (Tuesday) at the call of Anti Communalism Students Unity (ACSU).

The ACSU supporters called the indefinite strike to press home their three-point demand that included immediate resumption of the bus service between the campus and university rail station, development of railway tracks of the university shuttle train and punishment of those Shibir activists involved in the killing of their rivals.

The academic and administrative activities were totally disrupted due to this strike. The ACSU supporters locked both academic and administrative buildings of the university in the morning. They also continued to lay siege main gate of the university to prevent entry of motor vehicles into campus carrying university staffs and teachers.

Meanwhile, the ACSU activists have been agitating in the campus for the last ten days in support of their three-point demand.

However, the supporters of Islamic Chhatra Shibir and Jatiyabadi Chhatra Dal also lent support to the agitation programme.

Fresh police force deployed to maintain law and order on the campus and a tense situation now prevailing on the campus.
