## CU students boycotting classes

CHITTAGONG, Aug. 7:—The students of Chittagong University today refrained from attending their classes at the call of the Anti-Communalism Students Unity.

The students stayed away from their classes as a part of their two-day class boycott enforced from Saturday. But life on the campus passed off peacefully.

The Anti-Communalism Students Unity have been agitating in Chittagong University for the past one week in support of their 3-point demand that includes the immediate resumption of bus services in and around the university campus. The Unity also continued to lay siege to the university main gate to prevent the entry of motor vehicles into campus.

The Unity supporters threatened to go on indefinite strike in the university from next Tuesday till their demands were not met. The Islami Chhatra Shibir also called a one-day strike in Chittagong University next Monday for the same demands.
