

Strike paralyses CU

CHITTAGONG, Aug 10: Academic and administrative activities were totally disrupted at the Chittagong University today, the first day of indefinite strike called by Anti-Communal Student Forum (ACSF) to press home its demand for resumption of bus service.

In the morning the ACSF activists locked the main gate of the university and barred all vehicles from entering the campus. Classes and scheduled

examinations were not held. Even the CU Post Office and Agrani Bank CU branch remained closed.

During the strike, ACSF brought out a procession and held a rally in front of the Vice-Chancellor's office. Presided over by Ahsan Kabir Bengal, president of CU Chhatra Union, the rally was addressed, among others, by Shahjahan Choudhury, president of CU Chhatra League and Nurussafa Zulhash, President of CU Chhatra Front.

Meanwhile, Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) called class boycott programme for an indefinite period from tomorrow to realise the same demand. Presided over by Mujibur Rahman Munju, president of the organisation, Shibir held a meeting in front of the university library. Speakers at the meeting threatened the authority that they would launch greater agitation programme if their demand is not met immediately.
