

4 members of CU liaison body quit

CHITTAGONG, Feb 13: Four members of the newly formed eight-member Chittagong University Liaison Committee resigned today.

They are Prof Abdul Hakim, Prof Shamsuddin, Prof Abul Mansur and Prof Abu Zafar Ahmed.

The CU authorities formed the liaison committee on February 9 to help solve the crisis of the university.

The committee has been given responsibility for holding talks with the agitating student bodies on reopening of the university.

Shibir-led All-Party Student Alliance (APSA) continued their strike for the 14th day today.

APSA enforced strike for an indefinite period on February 1 demanding removal of VC, Proctor and Provosts of all halls of the university, release of 54 Shibir activists and arrest of the killers of two Shibir activists who were killed in a gunfight with BCL on the campus on December 19.

Meanwhile, at least 200 general students under the banner of 'General Students Council (GSC)' today laid a siege to the Central Railway Building (CRB) and submitted a memorandum to the General Manager (GM) of Bangladesh Railway (East) demanding immediate resumption of the university shuttle train service.

They urged the authorities concerned to resume shuttle train service by February 15.
