

APSA threatens to continue strike at CU

CHITTAGONG, Mar 29: All Party Student Alliance (APSA) of the Chittagong University (CU) at a press conference yesterday threatened to continue its on-going indefinite strike at CU.

The APSA leaders said any attempt to reopen the university with the help of police or BDR, before the restoration of a

congenial academic atmosphere, would prompt an intensified movement.

They also announced fresh agitation programmes side by side with its on-going indefinite strike that began February 1.

The programmes include student rally at Laldighi Maidan in the city on March 30, preparation for the grand rally of All Party Action Committee from March 31 to April 4, siege to Central Railway Building (CRB) on April 5, exchanging views with teachers, guardians and professionals on April 6, 7 and 8 and students grand rally at Hathazari on April 9.

They said CU authority has spoiled all the scopes for dialogue and lost its credibility as the VC & Pro-VC failed to solve the crisis.

Md Selim, convener of conference preparation committee, JCD, CU unit read out a written statement at the press conference while CU Shibir president Md Mojibur Rahman Monju, Mostafizur Rahman of Islami Chhatra Mojlish, Md Tajul Islam of combined students unity, Firoz Kabir Liton of Jatiya Chhatra Samaj and Mahfuzul Islam Chowdhury, convener of CU Sangram Chhatra Oikya spoke.
