DU campus peaceful, classes held

Barring stray incidents of firing and bomb blasts, the situation on Dhaka University campus remained comparatively peaceful on Sunday. Classes were held and the attendance of students was fairly good. Supporters of rival student organisations brought out separate processions and chanted slogans. There was no report of any clash.

Dhaka University Syndicate and the Educational Environment Council held separate meetings on the day to review the latest situation on the campus. Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor, the Syndicate meeting decided to take immediate
