

DU reopening by late Sept

Prof. Abdul Mannan, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University on Wednesday said that Dhaka University would be opened in the last week of the current month and specific date would be announced after Syndicate meeting by September 6.

He was talking to a group of

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students who demanded re-opening of the residential halls immediately.

Before meeting the Vice-Chancellor, the students damaged some doors of the Administrative Building including that of the VC's office and locked the gates.

The Vice-Chancellor faced the students and cautioned them to refrain from creating violences.

The D.U. authorities in a press release said that some students with an "illogical demand to get into residential halls at once showed unruly and indecent behaviour on Wednesday when the authorities were engaged in a meeting to review means and ways to implement the inquiry report."

The students hampered the administrative work by creating indiscipline and chanting various slogans and keeping the gates under lock and key" it alleged.

Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor, the meeting was attended by the Faculty Deans, hall Provosts, departmental heads, proctor, Directors of institutes and some senior teachers.

The meeting also requested the Vice-Chancellor to take effective measures against the unruly elements according to the university ordinance.
