DU Syndicate to take action against 17 students

Dhaka University Syndicate has accepted the recommendations of Disciplinary Committee and decided to take action against 17 students to improve the academic atmosphere in the University.

According to a University press release the Syndicate in its meeting on Saturday under the presidency of Vice-Chancellor Prof. J. Abdul Mannan decided to expel eleven students declaring them as undesirable, expel one student for two years and warned five others for their involvement in violent activities, misbehaviour and activities contrary to the law and order in the campus.

Farook (Avi)-3rd year (Hons.) in Political Science, Abu Hasan (Murad)-2nd year (Hons.) in Political Science; Abu Sayed Nashiruddin (Shipon) last part, Masters' degree in History; Sanaul Huq (Niru) appeared in Masters' degree examination in Philosophy; Shah-e-Akram-3rd year (Hons.) in Political Science; Shafiqul Islam (Shafiq) 1st year (Hons.) in Marketing. Mahbubur Rahman Khan (Mahbub) appeared in masters' degree examination in Political Science; A b d u l Malek-1st year (Hons.) in Management Quamruzzaman (Ratan)- Honours examinee in History, Bazlur Rahman Khan (Shahid)-Masters degree last part, in History and Elias Ali; 1st. part Master degree in Finance.

Mr. Golam Mortaza, diploma in library science has been expelled for two years.

Five students who have been warned are: Quamruzzaman Chowdhury (Babu) last part, MBA; Khan A. Mirza Masud (Jewel) — 1st year (hons) in management Hasibur Rahman (Mukur) 3rd year (Hons) in Management Nazimuddin (Alom) Diploma in Library Science and Iqbal Hossain, master of Demography.

It may be mentioned that an inquiry committee was constituted in July last to investigate the incidents of terrorist activities on D.U. campus, misbehaviour with the teachers and administration and unruly activities on the campus. The inquiry committee issued show cause notices to some students and asked them to reply the charges brought against them.

The disciplinary committee submitted its recommendations to the syndicate after reviewing the charges against student and the reply they gave.

The Syndicate accepted the recommendations but did not take action against two students due to lack of evidence against them.

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
