

Probe body on DU violence submits report

The inquiry committee which was formed by the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Abdul Mannan to investigate into the series of acts of violence at different times in Dhaka University has submitted its report on Monday.

This was revealed at the meeting of the Dhaka University educational environment council held at the administrative building.

The V-C said that the findings of the report has been forwarded to the disciplinary committee. As per the regulations of the University Ordinance the trouble mongers would be punished, the Vice-Chancellor added.

The meeting was addressed among others by Prof K.A.M. Saad Uddin, President of Dhaka University Teachers Association, Syndicate member Dr. Maniruzzaman Miah and student leaders.

Mr. Asaduzzaman Ripon and Mr. Moshtaq Hossain Presidents of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and Chatra League pro-JSD (Inu) respectively exchanged hot words in the discussion. Both of them demanded expulsion of each other's organisation from the Environment Council. Mr. Ripon said that the central leaders of JCD do not believe in politics of arms. However, he admitted that there could be armed hooligan's in the party's lower level.

Meanwhile the Syndicate of the university has sought an appointment with the President.
