

2 bodies set up to probe DU incidents

The Dhaka University authorities formed two separate committees to enquire into the incidents of two stabbings and indecent activities on the campus last Thursday night and Friday.

The five-member committee headed by the Provost of Fazlul Haq Hall will investigate the incidents of stabbing of two students, Rashed Ahmed Mitul of Bio-Chemistry and Shahriar Ali Shamim of Chemistry Departments. Both of them were stabbed on the "University Day" on Friday after they took snapshots of a girl students.

The second committee of seven-member will inquire into the "indecent and objectionable activities" which took place before the Rokeya Hall and adjacent to the Arts Faculty building area on the night before the University Day. The committee will submit its recommendations within next ten days.

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at a meeting on Saturday with the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Abdul Mannan in the chair. The meeting was attended, among others, by the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Hall Provosts, house tutors, leaders of the Dhaka University Teachers' Association and some senior teachers.

The meeting by a resolution expressed concern over the recent frequent movements of some armed youths at different points in the university campus with their cycle procession.

They also reiterated the call to the law enforcing agencies to take immediate disciplinary steps against these armed hoodlums to free the campus from terror.
