

2 held accused admit role in DU violence

Two accused persons A K M Manzurul Alam alias Litu and Nazre Moinuddin Khan Shimul who were arrested on Sunday from Dhanmondi area in Dhaka city along with one pistol and bullets, divulged some important and interesting information to police regarding recent violent activities on the Dhaka University campus.

According to police, both the arrested accused in a confessional statement to the magistrate at the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court on Monday admitted their offence. They also confessed that they were arrested while bringing the firearms and ammunition on
