2,500 nominations for DUCSU poll

About 2,500 candidates on Saturday filed their nomination papers against a total of 188 posts of Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) and 14 hall unions.

Saturday was the last date of filing the nominations, while the last date of withdrawal of the candidature has been set on May 31.

According to an unofficial report about 800 candidates have filed their nominations for 20 posts in the DUCSU and 1,900 for 168 posts in 14 hall student unions. Some 30 candidates filed nominations against each post in the DUCSU, according to the report.

About 200 students whose studentship were cancelled earlier got themselves readmitted to Dhaka University by Wednesday to contest the polls. Around 26,000 voters are scheduled to exercise their voting right in the ensuing DU-CSU and hall union polls scheduled to be held on June 6.

It may be mentioned here that the combine of nine student organisations split on the question of sharing posts in DUCSU. Chhatra Ekota Kendra and Chhatra Oikko Forum

have nominated separate panel in the DUCSU.

Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) submitted their panels for DUCSU in three separate groups led by Shamuzzaman Dudu, Asaduzzaman Ripon and Amanullah Aman, it is gathered.

The JCD also brought out three separate processions on the campus chanting slogans in support of the three panels.
