

Body formed to strengthen security

A high-level meeting on the law and order situation of Dhaka University was held on Monday in the Bangladesh Secretariat with Home Minister Mahmudul Hasan in the chair, reports BSS.

Education Minister Sheikh Shaidul Islam, Home Secretary Azimuddin Ahmed, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University, Professor Abdul Mannan, Inspector-General of Police Tayeb Uddin Ahmed, Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner Nasrullah Khan, Additional Inspector General of Police, Special Branch HMB Zaman and senior officials of education and home ministry were present in the meeting.

The meeting was convened following a directive of President Ershad to the Home Ministry to undertake steps on an emergency basis to ensure and improve existing law and order situation in the Dhaka University.

The meeting discussed threadbare various aspects relating to improvement of law and order in the DU campus.

With a view to strengthening security measure and check infiltration of outsiders in the DU campus the committee formed a 5-member committee headed by Joint Secretary (Political) of Home Ministry. The committee has been asked to submit its recommendation within next 7 days.

In the interest of bringing back congenial academic atmosphere the meeting appealed to the political parties, students, teachers, guardians and people of all walks of life to cooperate with the government to regain the glory of the Dhaka University.
