DU classes resume

All classes of Dhaka University resumed on Thursday as the campus reopened after 33 days of unscheduled closure, reports UNB.

Police are guarding all entrances to the campus closed to public transport. Only university vehicles were allowed entry.

On the opening day, most classes were held, but attendance was thin.

Meanwhile, most resident students have returned to their respective halls. Authorities opened all the 14 halls on Wednesday.

The university was closed by a government order on October 13 and residents were asked to vacate their halls by the following morning in the wake of an intense opposition agitation since October 10.

However, teachers and students started attending classes from Monday (November 12), three days ahead of the official reopening of the varsity, protesting the Educational institutions (Law and Order) Ordinance that shut the campus.
