

Withdrawal of Edn Ordinance urged

The Dhaka University Syndicate in a resolution on Saturday called upon the government to withdraw its Article 13 of Educational Institutions Ordinance-1990 by dint of which the government had closed down the University on October 15 night.

The resolution was adopted in a meeting of the syndicate with the Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah in the chair. The syndicate felt that the new government ordinance had affected the legal authority of the syndicate since the right to re-open and close down the university was empowered to the syndicate only according to the University Order-1973.

In another resolution the syndicate requested the Vice-Chancellor to persuade enactment of

the withdrawal by negotiating the issue with the government through Bangladesh University Parishad since the ordinance was applicable to all the universities.

The syndicate adopted the resolutions following an elaborate discussion on Article 13 of 1990.
