Immediate steps to resume DU classes urged

Education Action Committee of Dhaka University on Wednesday submitted a memorandum to the President and Chancellor of the Universities Abdur Rahman Biswas demanding immediate steps for resumption of classes of the university.

An eight-member delegation handed over the memorandum to the President and discussed with him the situation prevailing in the university.

In the memorandum the Action Committee said that the University Teachers' Association (DUTA) went on abstention from taking classes following a bloody gun battle on the campus on October 27, which causes death to three

persons including two students of the university.

The students said that the government was reluctant to taking effective measures to ensure peace on the campus of the educational institutions of the country. The DU teachers went on abstention demanding immediate steps for eradicating campus violence but the government was yet to take any actions in the regard, they added.

The students urged this government to fulfil the demands of the teachers and help resume the classes.
