New residential hall for DU students

DHAKA, (BSS): A new residential hall for the students of Dhaka University would be constructed after the name of Dr Shamsul Alam Khan Milon, who was killed during the recent mass movement against autocracy.

This was conveyed to an 11-member delegation of All-Party students' Unity (APSU) which called on the Acting President at his official residence here Tuesday evening.

The APSU delegation thanked the Acting President for holding the parliamentary elections in a free and fair manner. They said they had formed students brigade as volunteers for maintaining peace in a large number of polling centres on the election day.

The APSU delegation also told the Acting President that they would continue to play their due role for achieving the objectives for which a neutral interim government had been formed under him.

The APSU leaders, however, said some of their demands still remain unfulfilled.

Justice Shahabuddin highly appreciated the role of APSU in regard to the elections. He also mentioned that the application for help in medical treatment of Mr Mazhar, a student of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, is under active consideration. Mazhar was wounded in the incident in which Dr Milon was killed during the mass movement.
