the President of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists Reazuddin Ahmed and a representative of the Home Ministry with the rank and status of a Joint Secretary. Mr. Nuruddin M. Kamal, Joint Secretary Ministry of Education, will act as the member-Secretary of the committee.

A PID Handout Tuesday said, the education system has been seriously hampered due to the increase of violence on the varsity campuses in the recent years. As a result, various problems, including session Jam, have cropped up in case of university education.

The committee will identify the direct and indirect causes of violence on the university campuses. It will also determine possible and long-term measures for stopping violence on the campus and will also consider other relevant matter.

The committee will submit its report to the government within four weeks.
