

DU calm

Dhaka University Campus was calm on Sunday. Although the students were panicky. No violent incident was reported.

Moin Hoosain Raju, a central leader of Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU), was shot dead in a fierce gunbattle between the activists of Awami Chhatra League (A-C) and pro-BNP Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) on the campus on Friday afternoon.

Meanwhile, Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO) an alliance of Eight-left leaning student organisation including the pro-CPB Bangladesh Chhatra Union, brought out a Protest procession and held a rally on the campus.

The rally organised in front of Dhaka University central mosque premises, was addressed among others by GCO leaders Rokunuzzaman Rokon, Mostak Alam Tahir and Salim Hossain.

The GCO leaders blamed pro-BNP Jatiyabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) for killing of Raju. Terming the killing as a conspiracy against the democratic movement to fur-
