## Police raid two DU halls

Police raided two residential halls of Dhaka University early Saturday but failed to arrest anyone as "terrorists" staged a new-style escape, reports UNB.

A huge contingent of police cordoned off and entered Salimullah Hall at about 6 am in a hunt for terrorists and arms in the wake of unabated violence on the campus.

Sensing the police presence, a number of trouble makers mingled with general student activists came

out of the hall in an impromptu procession.

Residents said most of the processionists carried arms, leaving none for police who later searched some rooms and returned empty-handed.

Simultaneously, police also raided the beleaguered Zahurul Huq Hall, the stronghold of Chhatra League 'Montu group'. Here also, the terrorists managed to evade arrest.

Police left the halls after hour-long abortive raids, and those wanted by them reportedly staged comeback into their respective shelters shortly afterwards.
