Shifting of DU Social Welfare Institute urged

Students of the Social Welfare Institute of Dhaka University Saturday staged demonstration demanding resignation of its Director, reports UNB.

They also demanded immediate shifting of the institute to the main campus of the university.

During the demonstration, a rally was held. It was addressed by student representatives of the institute ABM Mosharraf Hossain, Wazed Kamal and Shamsul Alam Liton.

The speakers blamed the university authorities for reluctance towards their demands and threatened a greater movement if these were not met immediately.

They demanded that the institute be shifted to the Atomic Energy Commission premises after the commission's relocation to Savar.

If necessary, the student representatives said, they would go on hunger strike unto death to press home their demands.

They called upon the institute students to make a success today's programme to the Director's office under lock and key.

The students will go for an indefinite class boycott on October 25, if the demands are not met by October 24.
