DU probe body formed Students, employees observe strike

Classes in Dhaka University were not held and all administrative works were suspended on Tuesday as DU employees and two student organisations simultaneously called a general strike in the University in protest against the violent incident at the Administrative building in which a central leader of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) was killed and three employees of DU were injured on Monday last.

Uncertain calm was prevailing on the campus on Tuesday following the incident. The presence of the students on the campus and at the Teacher-Student Centre (TSC) was thin.

Jinnahtul Islam Jinnah, a Masters first part student of Institute of Food and Nutrition and drama Secretary of JCD Central Committee was killed on Monday by a group of unidentified miscreants at the University Administrative building and one Abdus Satter, Section Officer of Jashimuddin Hall, Abdul Alim, a peon of the Accounts section of DU and Haider Ali, a guard of the Institute of Business Administration (IBA) got

serious bullet injuries.

The condition of the injured persons were improved Tuesday, hospital sources said.

Seriously injured, Abdus Satter, who was in intensive care unit at Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) was transferred to general ward as his condition improved further.

Other injured are gradually improving at Pangu Hospital and DMCH.

The body of Jinnahtul Islam Jinnah was sent to his village at North Kalikapur under Dewangonj Union of Jamalpur district for burial.

constituted a probe body with Prof. Anwarullah Chowdhury, Chairman of Anthropology Department as Chairman of the Committee to investigate into the incident.

The meeting presided over by Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed, Vice-Chancellor of the University in a resolution urged the government to take effective measures to ensure security of the teachers, students and employees of the University.

The Syndicate, the highest decision making body of the University decided to bear all expenses for proper treatment of the injured DU officers and employees.

The meeting condemned the act of violence and demanded exemplary punishment of the persons responsible for the incident.

The Syndicate members expressed their deep sympathy

to the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the salvation of the departed soul of late JCD leader.

The meeting also prayed for the early recovery of the injured employees of the University.

EMPLOYEES RALLY

Leaders and activists of Dhaka University Employees Association brought out a procession and held a rally on the campus demanding security of the employees of the university.

The rally organised in front of the University Administrative building was addressed by leaders of the different employee's association.

The leaders demanded immediate arrest and trial of the persons responsible for the incident.

GCO PRESS CONFERENCE

Meanwhile, Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO), alliance

of seven left-leaning student organisations at a press conference Tuesday blamed the JCD for the violent incident.

The press conference organised at the University Madhu's Canteen was addressed among others by GCO leaders Ruhin Hossain Prince, Ahad Ahmed, Belal Chowdhury, Abdullah Hili Quayyum and Udaya Pal.

The GCO leaders called upon the law enforcing agencies for arresting armed hoodlums from the University campus.

The leaders demanded of the University authorities for expulsion of the persons responsible for the violent incident from the university.

The GCO announced its next programme of action. The programme includes holding of anti-terrorist rallies in different student dormitories of the University, submission of memorandum to the Vice-

Chancellor, sit-in demonstration in front of the V.C's office and holding of teachers, guardians and students' rally.

BCL RALLY

Bangladesh Chhatra League (M-I), student wing of Awami League Tuesday brought out a procession and held a rally on Dhaka University campus in protest against the Monday's violent incident on DU campus.

The rally organised in front of Madhu's canteen was addressed by Mr. K. H. M. Lulu and Mr. Pankaj Nath, President and General Secretary respectively of BCL (M-I) DU Unit.

The leaders demanded immediate arrest and trial of the persons responsible for the incident.

The leaders blamed JCD for the violent incident and demanded expulsion of the persons responsible for the incident from the university.
