DU programmes on Dec 14, 16

The Dhaka University authorities have drawn-up separate programmes in observance of the Martyred Intellectual Day and the Victory Day on December 14 and 16 respectively.

The Martyred Intellectual Day programmes include assembly of teachers, students, officials and employees at the Aparajeo Bangla at 6.45 a.m. and placing floral wreaths at the graveyard adjacent to University Central Mosque, and memorials of Jagannath Hall, Shaheed Minar residential area and Fuller Road. They will visit the Mirpur Martyred Intellectuals Graveyard at 7.30 a.m. A discussion will be held at the TSC auditorium at 10 a.m. with Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed in the chair. Offices of the university will remain closed from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the day for the discussion which will be attended by teachers, students, officials, and employees. A special munajat will be held after Zohr prayer at the University Central Mosque seeking divine peace of the departed soul of the martyred intellectuals.

The programmes of the Victory Day include hoisting the national flag at different buildings of the university at 6.30 a.m., assembly of teachers, students, officials and employees at the Aparajeo Bangla at 7.30 a.m. and then they will visit the Savar National Mausoleum. A doa mahfil will be held at the University Central Mosque after Juma prayer seeking prosperity and progress of the nation.
