### DU teachers slate DUTA leaders' statement

122 teachers of Dhaka University in a joint statement to the press on Saturday condemned and expressed their deep concern over a statement made by Prof. Shahadat Ali and Dr. Arefin Siddique, President and General Secretary respectively of Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA), criticising the recent speech made by Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia at the grand rally of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at Shapla Chattar.

They said that the statement made by DUTA leaders were not based on Dhaka University teacher community's opinion.

They termed the statement as an exploitation by DUTA

Leaders of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at a rally on Saturday strongly criticised Prof. Shahadat Ali and Arefin Siddique, President and General Secretary of Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) for their statement against the speeches of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia at Shapla Chattar crossing.
