

## DU urged to take control of Kataban mosque

Different student organisations in a meeting on Saturday expressed concern over using the Kataban mosque as a camp by anti-liberation Jamaat-Shibir and demanded of the Dhaka University authorities to bring the mosque under the university administration.

The meeting said that the Jamaat-Shibir elements have been using the Kataban Mosque as their "training centre" for a long time. The mosque has been turned into a business centre by the Shibir members and people in general are not allowed to say their prayer there, they added.

They urged the authorities concerned to take necessary measures to evict the Shibir elements from the Kataban Mosque and to open the mosque for general people.

They also urged general students of Dhaka University to extend support to the movement for bringing the Kataban Mosque under the University administration.
