## LDF opposes DU ban on student politics

The central leaders of the Left Democratic Front in a meeting on Saturday opposed the Government's policy of restricting political activities on Dhaka University campus.

The meeting pointed out that initiative had been taken to impose restriction on the political activities of student organisations on the campus following the failure of the Government to stop armed terrorism.
