No classes held in DU

No classes were held in the Dhaka University Sunday as pro-Awami League Chhatra League enforced a student strike to press for resignation of Vice-Chancellor Pro Emajuddin Ahmed and postponing the DUCSU election, reports UNB.

The strike call was given by Chhatra League on Thursday.

Addressing a rally in front of "Aparajeyo Bangla" on the campus at noon, Chhatra League President Mainuddin Hasan Chowdhury announced their decision to boycott today's (Monday) all-party meeting called by the VC.

The Chhatra League leader threatened of another strike on the DU campus on March 29 if the VC did not postpone the DUCSU election scheduled for April 12.

March 29 is the last date for submission of nomination papers for the April 12 polls. Earlier, the University authorities had to extend the nomination submission date from March 27 to March 29 due to the strike called by Chhatra League.

Chhatra League sources said they may call a hartal on April 12 if the DU authorities go ahead with the DUCSU election on the day.

The rally was also addressed by Iqbalur Rahim, KHM Lizu and Pankaj Devnath.
