DU Syndicate polls White, Blue panels share seats

White and Blue panels shared seats in the election of Dhaka University Syndicate, Academic Council and Finance Committee, held Sunday, reports UNB.

The two panels bagged three seats each out of the six teachers' representatives in the 17-member Syndicate, the highest policy-making body of the university.

The Pink panel which also contested the elections failed to secure any seat.

In the Academic Council, the Blue panel bagged four while the white panel captured two out the six elected teachers' representatives from the associate professor and assistant professor/lecturer categories.

The newly elected Syndicate members from six categories; Dean, Provost, Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant professor and Lecturer-are : Prof M Mashhuzzaman, Dean of Science Faculty (Blue), Prof Zinnatun Nessa Tahmida Begum, Provost of Rokeya Hall (White), Prof AK Azad Chowdhury of Pharmacy Department (Blue), Dr Mohammad Anwar Hossain of Bio-Chemestry (Blue), Dr Mosleh Uddin Ahmed of Public Administration (White), and Mohammad Mizanur Rahman of Marketing (White).

The elected Academic Council members from Associate professor category : Dr Mohammad Abul Bashar of Zoology (White), Dr Galib Ahsan Khan of Philosophy (Blue), and Dr Shawkat Hossain of English Department (Blue).

Academic Council members from Assistant Professor/Lecturer category : Dr Mohammad Anwarul Islam of Chemistry (White), Ali Akkas of Management (Blue) and Dr Shahid Akhter Hussain of Soil Science Department (Blue).

Prof Anwar Hossain of Business Administration (White) has been elected as the teachers representative in the Finance Committee.

The elections, held simultaneously at TSC of the university, were conducted by DU Treasurer Prof Shahiduddin Ahmed.
