Admission of 80 DU students cancelled

The admission of 80 students of Dhaka University stands cancelled as they failed to prove authenticity of their entry into the varsity, said a DU official on Wednesday, reports UNB.

An official announcement cancelling their admission will be made soon, as the accused Master's preliminary students couldn't reply to the show-cause notice, served on them earlier, within the deadline which expired on Wednesday.

The DU administrative authorities are apprehending threat of reprisals following the expulsion decision against the 80 students charged with fake admission.

A group of unruly students already rushed to the office of a Deputy Registrar of the University on Wednesday morning and allegedly threatened with dire consequences if the decision was not rescinded.

Some officials are learnt to have been received anonymous letters threatening attempts on their lives. Alarmed by the detection of the admission fraud, the university authorities have formed a 5-member committee, headed by ABM Khaled, Dean of the Commerce Faculty, to check such forgery.
