

DU exam schedule changed

The examination schedule of BSC Honours (1993) for January 3, to be held at the Curzon Hall has been shifted for unavoidable circumstances, says UNB.

Under the revised timing the examinations scheduled to begin from 9 a.m. will now be held on January 4 from 2.30 p.m. while the examinations scheduled on 1.30 p.m. will be held from 2.30 p.m. on the same date (January 3), said a DU Press release on Sunday.

The schedule and place of other examinations will remain unchanged.
