JCD demands announcement of DUCSU polls date

Leaders of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at a rally on Wednesday demanded of the Dhaka University authorities to announce the election date of Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU).

Addressing the rally JCD leaders alleged that the scheduled date of DUCSU elections were postponed twice due to violent activities of pro-Awami Chhatra League (S-P).

JCD leaders said that leaders of Awami League and its student front Chhatra League (S-P) are opposing the DUCSU and hall unions fearing their defeat.
