

DU classes resume today

The classes of Dhaka University resumed today (Saturday) amidst an uneasy atmosphere.

Campus sources said that most of the outsider armed-cadres, who left the halls after raids, started returning again. Armed outsiders were seen guarding the entry points of different residential halls and in some cases they also imposed restrictions on the free movement of resident students by locking the collapsible gates of the halls. A tense situation is prevailing in the Zahrul Haq Hall. Three rival groups—the pro-Awami League Chhatra League (S-P), Jatiya Party-backed Jatiya Chhatra Samaj and Chhatra League (M-L), a faction of Chhatra League (S-P)—were staying in the Zahrul Haq Hall.

Jatiya Chhatra Samaj-backed outsiders have been become active in the Zahrul Haq Hall after raid. On the other hand supporters of Chhatra League (S-P), who were forced to vacate the hall earlier, returned to the hall, while Chhatra League (M-L) who occupied the hall became weak after the arrest of Masum Ahmed and some others.
