

DU Senate requisition meet postponed

Dhaka University authorities postponed a much-talked special requisition meeting of its Senate scheduled on Friday following the opinion of the outgoing Attorney General, reports UNB.

The meeting was due to discuss corruption, politicisation and partiality allegedly committed by the Vice-Chancellor and his administration.

It was convened as a number of Senators demanded formation of a committee to investigate the allegations.

The meeting was, however, decided to be held after opinion of the Attorney General as to whether the Senate is capable of forming such committee.

But, sources said, the Attorney General, before his resignation, had expressed negative opinion on the matter for which the meeting was postponed on Thursday.

The postponement decision angered several Senators as they think that such committee should be formed for the transparency of the university administration.

"It was our moral demand for forming a committee to investigate the alleged corruption as public fund is involved with the matter," said a leading Senator, Dr AAMS Arefin Siddique.

Dr. Arefin, also General Secretary of DU Teachers Association, once again said investigation could be conducted on any allegation and for this there was no need to seek opinion from anyone.
