

JCD calls strike in DU tomorrow

Jatiyabadi Chhatra Dal on Tuesday gave a call for a students' strike at Dhaka University campus on July 4 to protest the police of "violence killings, and police oppression, as perpetrated by the Awami League government," says BSS.

Addressing a Press conference at the National Press Club JCD central leaders demanded the release of arrested party leaders and withdrawal of "false cases" against JCD activists, the leaders alleged that a large number of JCD activists have been arrested since the formation of Awami League government. Awami League and Chhatra League activists, with the assistance of the law enforcing agencies, have killed five JCD leaders, they added.

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They said that the law and order situation of the country is seriously deteriorating since the incertion of new government.

JCD central President Fazlul Haque Milon read out a written speech in which he listed Awami League offences against the party, among others, JCD Central General Secretary Nazimuddin Alam MP Organising Secretary Abul Khair Bhuiyan, Senior vice-President Maniruzzaman Manir, Joint Secretary Shaheduddin Chwodhury, Any Party leader Nasurddin Ahmed Pintu, Shirin Sultana, Monowar Hossain Rana, Habibunnabi Sheel, a.B.M. Mosharraf Hossain and Manir Hossain were presented the Press conference.
