

Uneasy calm on DU campus

An uneasy calm prevailed in Dhaka University on Friday as armed outsiders consolidated their position in the dormito-

ries they had occupied in last three days, reports UNB.

Resident students said they had been passing days in anxiety and feared that fresh violence might erupt any moment between the two belligerent student groups who are equipped with firearms.

Vice Chancellor Prof Emajuddin Ahmed threatened to step down if the overall situation on the campus was not

improved and the outsiders were not driven out by today Saturday.

The university authorities suspended all classes and academic activities for three days till (Saturday).

However, no untoward incident took place on Friday in Mohsin Hall, AF Rahman Hall, Shahidullah Hall which had been captured by the ruling party backed student organisation in last three days.
