

Uneasy calm prevails in Dhaka varsity

An uneasy calm prevailed in Dhaka University on Monday following Sunday's gunbattle between BCL (S-P) and JCD activists.

Attendance in classes was less than normal and riot police were posted at sensitive points on the campus.

Armed cadres were seen moving in the university area. BCL activists staged demonstrations in front of S.M. Hall and residence of the Vice-Chancellor.

They raised anti-JCD and anti-government slogans.

Police on Monday did not allow movement of all mechanised transports through the university area. Only rickshaws, in small numbers, plied.
