DU Dean polls

Blue Panel wins 3 seats, white 4 seats

Awami League-backed Blue Panel and BNP-backed White Panel shared the seven posts of Dean of Dhaka University in the election held on Wednesday.

The Blue Panel won three posts of Dean while White Panel bagged four posts. The Pink Panel supported by left leaning parties, contested in the election but failed to win any of the posts of Dean.

In the last election held in 1995 the Blue Panel had only one post and White Panel won five while the rest one went to Pink Panel. This year the Blue Panel improved its position by winning three posts. The winners are Prof. Dr. Munir Uddin Ahmed who is elected uncontested as the Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy, Dr. Kazi Shahidullah Professor of History and Dr. Abul Hashem, Professor of Accounting had been elected as Dean of Faculty of Arts and Faculty of Business Studies respectively from

the Blue Panel.

The White Panel winning are Dr. M. Ershadul Bari, Professor of Law as Dean of Faculty of Law, Md. Asaduzzaman, Professor of Public Administration (Dean of Faculty of Social Science), Dr. A.K.M. Sirajul Islam Khan, Professor of Micro Biology (Dean of Faculty Biological Science) and Dr. Md. Shafi Chowdhury, Professor of Physics as (Dean of Faculty of Science).

The election was held in the Games Room of Teachers Students Centre (TSC) from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. About one thousand teachers of different faculties participated in the polls to elect the Deans of different faculties. Prof. M. Shamsul Haq, Treasurer of the university, conducted the election. Deans of seven faculties of the university are elected for a two-year term.
