DU keeps 20 seats for FFs' sons, daughters

The Admission Committee of the Dhaka University has kept only 20 seats in the reserved quota for the sons and daughters of the freedom fighters this academic session.

According to sources, other universities of the country have made provision to keep one per cent of the total intake of the students in the reserved quota for admission into the degree level courses for the sons and daughters of the freedom fighters.

When contacted Vice-Chancellor of the Dhaka University Prof. A.K. Azad Chowdhury told the Bangladesh Observer that the university authority was actively considering to increase the number of seats in the reserved quota for the sons and daughters of the freedom fighters. He said that the Dhaka University would also follow the provision of keeping 'one per cent quota' as reserved seats for the freedom fighters' sons and daughters.
